Yesterday we had a small opening ceremony as the building was officially handed over to us from the contractor. Our current EYFS children will remain in the original EYFS classroom until the end of the year.

During the summer break the contractors will return to Loughborough C of E and will be demolishing the old EYFS building. We will then begin putting the plans of our school council into action by creating a planting and garden area as well and using the canopy as a covered seating area on the playground. Our school grounds will look very different when we return to school next academic year.

Now that the building works are complete and the security fencing is removed, it is safe for us to use the playground gate near to the tyre park to drop pupils off in the morning and collect at the end of the day. Thank you as always for your continued support.

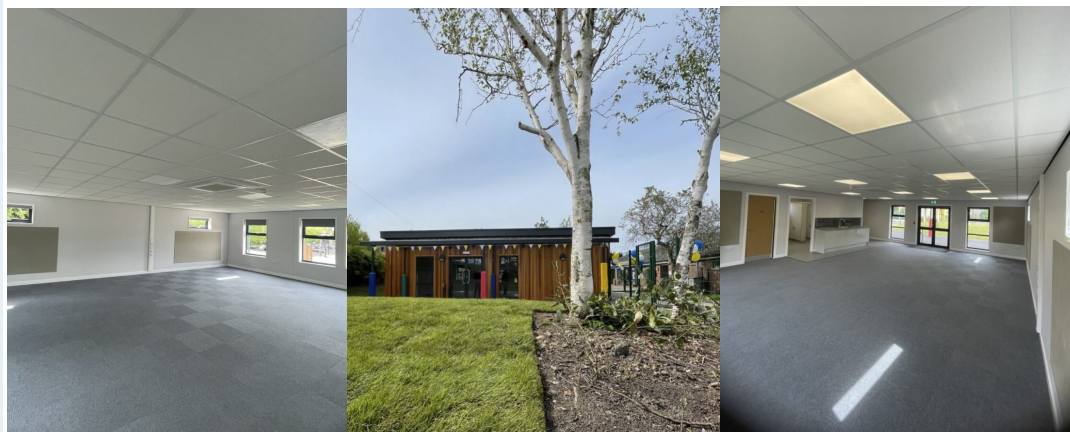
